During the briefer proper, Director Annabelle V. Briones presented ITDI's agency history, and current services and facilities. With her was MSD Chief Dr. Marianito T. Margarito who brought with him samples of two new products, the nanocomposite filament for 3D printed prosthetics and Carbon Quantum Dots (CQDs).

For PNR, General Manager Deovanni S. Miranda shared updates on the North-South Commuter Railway and South Long Haul (SLH). He was followed by Usec. Reynaldo B. Mapagu, PVAO Administrator, who discussed the activities for their 83rd *Araw ng Kagitingan* Celebration and 2025 Philippine Veterans Week.

Some 15 media practitioners joined the Question and Answer Session for Series 1. Several others joined through the live-stream. The proceedings of Series 1 were broadcasted in the social media website of ITDI, and 16 regional and 78 provincial information centers of PIA.

Meanwhile, newly sworn in IDS Head, Jose Ramon Cuevas, added that "We are preparing for Series 2 to 7 of the press conference which are booked every first Friday of the month."
